IMPORTANT NOTE: If you do not file the jury demand with the Court and pay the proper jury fees by the filing deadline (see Deadline for Completion below), you

will permanently waive your right to a jury trial.

Deadline for Completion: Ten (10) calendar days (which includes Saturdays, Sundays and holidays) from the

date on which the not guilty plea was filed on the case at the Milwaukee Municipal Court: if the 10th calendar day falls on a non-business, the deadline is the next business

day

Additional Instructions: The following information must be completed on the form before it can be filed with the

court:

<u>Defendant</u>: If this is a case against you, fill in your name.

Court Date: See original citation. Also known as the appearance date.

Violation Date: See violation description section of original citation.

346.63(5), which prohibit Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) or Operating with a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration (PAC). Per Wis. Stat. 800.035(5)(c), any companion case(s), including 343.305(3)–Refusal, will also be transferred to Circuit Court for the

required hearing if the OWI and/or PAC cases are accepted for a jury trial.
